CLASSROOM LABS

Herpetology 101

Across Florida, you can find reptiles and amphibians slithering and leaping. Discover what makes these animals unique, and learn to identify some of their key characteristics. This program includes interactions with our live reptile and amphibian ambassadors.



Plankton Encounter

Investigate the vast amount of life within a water drop. Students collect and identify plankton using microscopes and learn about its role in ocean health.

Invertebrate Investigation

Roll up your sleeves and get up-close and personal with the animals that live in the Tampa Bay estuary. Students interact with various invertebrates, practicing observation skills and scientific classification.
